Graduated in Pharmacy since 2000 and Pharmacy PhD since 2005 with the award of Extraordinary Prizes (Complutense University) . I have an expertise training in research and teaching activities, having the title as "Profesora Titular de Universidad" since November 2018. Since I finished my degree I worked in the predoctoral stage at Dpt. of Human Genetics (Spanish National Cancer Centre, CNIO) under the direction of Javier Benitez. The postdoctoral stage started at the CNIO, followed by nearly 5 month of stay in MD Anderson Cancer Center in Houston. After considering jobs offer at Sant Jude Hospital and MD Anderson Cancer Center, I returned to Granada applying to Juan de la Cierva Program in the Dpt. of Computational Sciences and Artificial Intelligence. From March 2012, I had a position as Professor (Dpt.of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology III and Immunology), which is currently developed in combination of research tasks and students supervising (4 PhD students, and Master students).At the same time, I actively collaborate with "Gene expression regulation and Cancer" group at the Centre for Genomics and Oncological Research (GENYO). I am principal research of "Genética del cáncer, biomarcadores y terapias experimentales" at de IBS_Granada since Januray 2020. Moreover, I am as a main resaercher in 5 proyects and as a collaborator researcher in more than 20 projects. I have experience with publications in high impact journals. Specifically I participated in 40 scientific papers in the biomedicine and oncology field, most of them in Q1 standing (3o sexenios de investigación). I have also participated in 3 international chapters of books. I have presented more than 30 communications at international conferences. I have 3 patents and 1 sexenio de transferencia. H index (1*) and Research gateindex (34.92). Recently, I have been accredited by full professor.
